Armagh Annual Pilgrimage to Lourdes 10 – 15th May 2026 will take place from the 10th to the 15th May 2026. The pricing for the May Pilgrimage has been structured slightly different as from previous years.

The Accueil Notre Dame: For our Assisted Pilgrims sharing in the Accueil fares will be €1,050.00 (this includes JWT Travel Insurance) The Agena and The Jeanne D'arc will be €1,020.00 per person sharing. The single room supplement for these hotels will have an additional €195.00.

The St Sauveur will cost €1,020.00 per person sharing. The single room supplement for this hotel will cost an additional €235.00.

The La Solitude will cost €1,040.00 per person sharing. The single Room supplement for this hotel will cost an additional €245.00.

These prices exclude travel insurance into the hotels. JWT Pilgrimage Travel Insurance will cost €55 per person for up to 79 years & €75 per person 80-94 years.
